Message from Mayor Buontempo:

Good evening. This is Mayor Greg Buontempo once again.

Today we received notice of three additional cases of COVID-19 among Holmdel residents, bringing our total to 30. I want to clarify that this number of 30 cases are among Holmdel residents *only* and does not include cases at Bayshore Medical Center or the state testing site.

While we are unable to disclose the locations of these residents, I must implore you to continue to wash your hands, sanitize surfaces, maintain proper social distancing and self-isolation. This is the only way that we can slow the spread in our community.

As you may have heard, many hospital systems are reaching out to retired doctors and nurses who are willing to help battle this virus. Our own Bayshore Medical Center is one of those hospitals.
