Message from Mayor Buontempo:

Good evening. This is Mayor Greg Buontempo again.

Governor Murphy closed all state and county parks today. This is largely due to the fact that people are not practicing proper social distancing. As I said last night, Holmdel municipal parks will remain open. However, if there are gatherings, group sports, use of playgrounds, basketball courts, golfing, or other violations we will be forced to reconsider this status.

We understand that people want to enjoy our beautiful parks in Holmdel, especially as the weather improves. However, it is imperative that regulations are followed, so that we can continue to flatten the curve. The better we practice isolation; the sooner we will be able to resume normal activity.

Also, tomorrow the testing site at PNC Arts Center will be open to the public. Over the past week the Center has seen reduced demand, and they have additional capacity. If you are exhibiting symptoms and believe you should be tested, I urge you to make use of the resource we have right here in Holmdel. Testing is free and the site opens at 8am. When the site reaches capacity, it closes the line. Therefore, as long as you are in line, and exhibiting symptoms, you will be tested.
