## Recycling Info

- In the event of inclement weather visit our website to determine if curbside collection has been cancelled
- To obtain recycling decals to label your container please call or email the Recycling Center
- Residents may bring recyclables to the DPW, Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 7:15am - 12:00pm and 12:30pm - 3:00pm, including:
  - Computer and electronic equipment
  - Second chance toys
- Metal recycling may be dropped off at the DPW on 1/21, 2/18, 3/18, 11/18, 12/16 from 8am-12pm and 12:30-2pm
- For Hazardous Waste Material contact the Monmouth County Reclamation Center at (732) 683-8686
- Common household alkaline batteries should be disposed of in the regular trash
- Plastic bags (e.g.: grocery bags, bread bags, recycling film, etc) can be dropped off at the Holmdel Town Hall lobby or DPW facility
- Recycling will not be picked up if commingled with any plastic bags
- Styrofoam recycling can be brought to the Middletown Recycling Center (52 Kanes Lane; Middletown)
- There are no recognized holidays in 2022 that conflict with Recycling Schedule

## Brush Pick Up (week of)

<b>Section A</b>	<b>4/4</b>	<b>5/30</b>	<b>8/29</b>
<b>Section B</b>	<b>4/11</b>	<b>6/6</b>	<b>9/5</b>
<b>Section C</b>	<b>4/18</b>	<b>6/13</b>	<b>9/12</b>
<b>Section D</b>	<b>4/25</b>	<b>6/20</b>	<b>9/19</b>

- ONE pick-up per household, per collection. Brush put out late will not be collected. The first pick-up may be as early as 7:00 a.m.
- Brush must not be stacked at the curb any earlier than (1) week prior to your scheduled week of collection. Violators may be subject to fines.
- Tree limbs MUST be 6 inches in diameter or smaller.
- The maximum amount of brush per household is (3) individual piles with each pile not exceeding 4' high by 4' wide by 6' long.
- Leave at least 6' of space on each side and between each pile so machinery can grasp the material, if not, it cannot be removed.
- Do not place branches in the roadway or sidewalk.
- Do not stack piles beside shrubbery, posts, hydrants, electrical or cable boxes, mailboxes, and/or other objects.
- Professionals hired by the resident are responsible for the removal of branches/brush.
- Brush removal is restricted to residents of the Township only. Brush will not be collected from commercial businesses.
- ONLY tree branches and limbs are acceptable; brush mixed with stumps, roots, leaves, grass, dimensional lumber, firewood, or over-sized material are not acceptable and will be refused.
- Brush must be stacked perpendicular to the curb.
- Brush must not be stacked within 10 feet of a storm-water inlet/basin.

## Leaf Pick Up (starts on)

- ONE pick-up per household, per collection. Leaves put out late will not be collected. The first pick-up may be as early as 7:00 a.m.
- Leaves must be placed in a "wind row" pile no earlier than (1) week prior to your scheduled week of collection. Violators may be subject to fines.
- Do not place leaves in bags.
- Do not mix leaves with grass clippings, brush and/or general debris.
- The Township does not accept "call-in" residential requests.
- Do not place leaves at the curb during non-collection months. Residents are responsible for leaf disposal accumulated during non-collection months.
- Do not transport your leaves to the DPW facility.
- Do not dispose of your leaves in the storm-water inlets or catch basins along the roadways.
- Do not place leaves within 10' of a storm-water inlet or basin.
- The leaf removal service is restricted to Township residents only. Leaves will not be removed from commercial businesses.
