COVID-19 Update

Message from Mayor Buontempo:

Good evening. This is Mayor Greg Buontempo.

I am calling to provide you with three updates about the Township:

First, Holmdel Township has had two new COVID-19 cases since the beginning of November. As of today, the Township has had a total of 372 positive COVID-19 cases.

As we approach the winter months, I encourage all residents to remain vigilant. Monmouth County is providing multiple opportunities in the coming weeks to get your PCR test. Please see the Holmdel Township website or our Facebook page for details on where to get a test. Now is also a good time to get your annual flu shot in anticipation of flu season, which is fast approaching.

Secondly, Holmdel Township will be holding a Veterans Day ceremony next Wednesday, October 11th at 10:30 a.m. The ceremony will be held in Veterans Park on Telegraph Road. The Township invites all residents to join us in honoring all those who have served our country in all wars. Please keep in mind that masks and social distancing will be required during the ceremony.

Finally, the Holmdel Township Committee is holding a Thanksgiving Turkey Drive beginning this Monday and running through November 20th. To help our neighbors in need, we will be collecting frozen turkeys and grocery store gift cards for the purchase of food. If you are interested in making a donation, you can drop off your frozen turkey at the Town Hall lobby Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. There will be a security officer there to assist you, as Town Hall is currently closed to the public. You can drop off your grocery store gift card anytime by placing it in the silver Tax Payments drop-box in front of Town Hall. Please place your gift card into one of the envelopes provided in the entryway to Town Hall, and include your contact information so that we can provide you with a receipt.

Everyone needs help sometimes, but even more so during this time of pandemic. If your family is food insecure and you would like to receive a Thanksgiving food donation, please fill out the form on the Holmdel Township website and make sure to include your name, address, the number of people in your household and a phone number. Please be assured that your information will be kept confidential.
