Message from Mayor Buontempo:

Good evening. This is Mayor Greg Buontempo.

I hope that you and your family are well, and to those who are celebrating, Happy Hanukkah!

I am calling to provide you with four updates.

First, Holmdel Township currently has **77 new COVID-19 cases** since the beginning of December. As of this week, the Township has had a cumulative total of **621 positive COVID-19 cases**. We still have not reached the crest of the pandemic's second wave. If we each do our part, we can help to slow the spread of this virus and keep our community safe.

Second, the Governor has shared that 74% of New Jerseyans are not cooperating with contact tracing. If you are contacted by an official, please cooperate fully. This process helps to inform close contacts that they have potentially been exposed. Contact tracers will provide their name, agency, and a phone number. If you have any doubts about a tracer's legitimacy, contact the Monmouth County Health Department. Also feel free to request the name and ID of anyone who calls.

Third, all appointments for the Holmdel COVID-19 mobile test site have been booked. The Township Committee is in the process of securing a second date for the near future. Finally, I want to alert you to a new traffic pattern. The Township has installed a four-way stop at the intersection of Telegraph Hill Road and Takolusa Drive. Please be cautious and observe the new traffic pattern.
