## Message from Mayor Buontempo:

Good evening. This is Mayor Greg Buontempo.

Access to the COVID-19 vaccine continues to be a major priority for the Township Committee and we are committed to finding ways to help our residents register for a vaccine.

As a reminder, Holmdel Township has **two** COVID-19 vaccine distribution sites: one is located at Bayshore Medical Center and the other is located at Bell Works and is being sponsored by the VNA. There is also a Monmouth County vaccination site being hosted at Brookdale College. To register for an appointment at these distribution centers, you should visit their websites, which I will provide in my accompanying email. Vaccine appointments continue to be **extremely limited** at this time and so I encourage you to register for an appointment at all available sites and to take the first appointment that becomes available to you.

If you are senior resident who does not have access to the internet or if you are an otherwise eligible resident who has a disability which prevents you from accessing the VNA at Bell Works registration website, Holmdel Township is here to help! If you need such assistance, please call my office at (732) 946-2820 extension 1204. After answering some questions regarding your qualifications and needs, we will send a Community Emergency Response Team member to assist you with filling out your registration form. This is for registration only; it is not an appointment. You will be put on a wait list and will then be contacted by the V-N-A when there is an available appointment.

Finally, for those that are interested in our current case numbers, Holmdel Township has **13 new** COVID-19 cases since the beginning of February. As of today, the Township has a cumulative total of **1,082 positive** COVID-19 cases.

### **List of Medical Conditions Eligible to Receive a Vaccine:**

- Asthma
- Cancer
- Chronic Kidney Disease
- Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
- Down Syndrome
- Heart Conditions (heart failure, coronary artery disease, cardiomyopathy, etc)
- Obesity
- Sickle Cell Disease
- Type-2 Diabetes
- Chronic smoker
- Pregnancy (individuals should follow CDC guidance and first discuss the vaccination with their medical provider before receiving the vaccine)
