



# TOWNSHIP of HOLMDEL

COVID-19 Update  
February 12, 2021

Good evening. This is Mayor Greg Buontempo. I have three updates for you tonight.

First, in speaking with residents over the past few weeks, several of you have expressed concern about the issue of identity theft. As additional vaccination sites open up around the county and residents begin to get registered, I urge you to exercise caution and be alert for potential attempts to steal your private information.

Neither Holmdel Township nor any reputable vaccine center will **ever** ask for your social security number, bank accounts, credit card or debit card information. Generally speaking, unless you are making a **verified** payment with a vendor that you trust, you should not be giving out payment information over the telephone.

For those residents who are being assisted with registration by one of our Holmdel CERT Team volunteers, you **will** be asked for your **name, address, phone number and email, date of birth, and insurance** information as part of the registration process. If at any point you are concerned about the volunteer's identity, you can call Town Hall and our staff will help to verify that for you.

Second, there are three local options for vaccine registration: Bayshore Medical Center, the VNA site at Bell Works, and the Monmouth County Health Department site at Brookdale College. Registration information for all three sites will be included in my accompanying email. If you are unable to register online yourself, you can call my office for assistance.

Finally, for those who are interested in our current case numbers, Holmdel Township has **74 new** COVID-19 cases since the beginning of February. As of today, the Township has a cumulative total of **1,137** positive COVID-19 cases.

As always, I thank you for all you do to help move Holmdel Forward. Stay healthy and stay safe. Goodnight.

### **List of Medical Conditions Eligible to Receive a Vaccine:**

- Asthma
- Cancer
- Chronic Kidney Disease
- Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
- Down Syndrome
- Heart Conditions (heart failure, coronary artery disease, cardiomyopathy, etc)
- Obesity
- Sickle Cell Disease
- Type-2 Diabetes
- Chronic smoker
- Pregnancy (individuals should follow CDC guidance and first discuss the vaccination with their medical provider before receiving the vaccine)
