## Updates to New Jersey Pandemic Guidelines:

### As of May 7<sup>th</sup>:

- The prohibition on buffets and other self-service foods has been lifted
- The prohibition on indoor bar-side seating has been lifted
- Dance floors are now permitted at private catered events
- Outdoor capacity for large venues (greater than 1,000 seats) has increased to 50%

### As of May 19<sup>th</sup>:

- Complete removal of outdoor gathering limit
- Complete removal of the indoor dining 50% capacity limit
- Increase in private indoor gathering limits to 50 people
- Complete removal of all percentage capacity limits for indoor and outdoor businesses and houses of worship (subject to social distancing)
- Increase in indoor large venue (greater than 1,000 seats) capacity to 30%
- Indoor catered events, funerals or memorial services, performances, political activities, and commercial gatherings will be limited to a maximum of 250 people
